This results in remodeling of the soft tissue fibers, thereby creating new fiber and collagen. The non-surgical procedure delivers results with minimal pain and discomfort.

Leukoplakia (vulvar dystrophies); Herpes vaporization; Urethral caruncle vaporization; Cervical dysplasia; Benign and malignant tumor and hemangiomas.

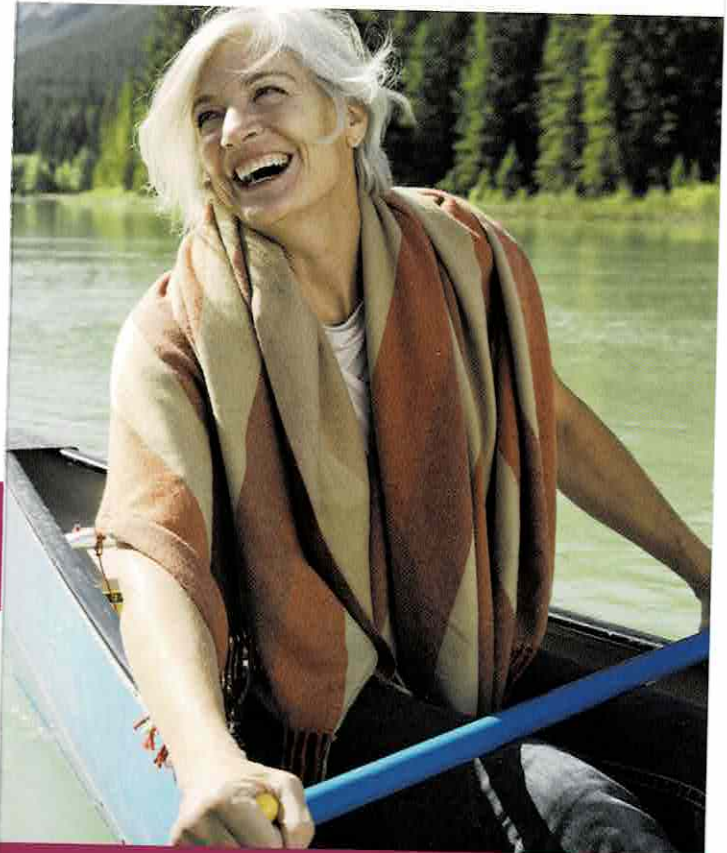

Endometrial lesions, including ablation of endometriosis; Excision/lysis of adhesions; Salpingostomy; Oophorectomy/ovariectomy; Fimbrioplasty; Metroplasty; Microsurgery (tubal); Uterine myomas and fibroids; Ovarian fibromas and follicle cysts; Uterosacral ligament ablation; Hysterectomy.
